HE HAS BOWLED ON SEVERAL LEAGUE CHAMPION TEAMS. HE BOWLED ON TWO CITY CHAMPION TEAMS AND WAS CLASS "A" DOUBLES CHAMPION TWO TIMES. LEO HAS BOWLED IN SEVERAL STATE TOURNAMENTS. HE WAS VERY HELPFUL IN CERTIFYING LANES IN THE OLD PASADENA LANES AND IN THE FAIR LANES HOUSES. HE WORKED ON THE CITY TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE ON RULES AND OTHER VARIOUS COMMITTEES.
