HARRY WAS A LONGTIME BOWLER IN THE PASADENA AND HOUSTON AREA AND A PAST PRESIDENT AND LIFE MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PASADENA BOWLING ASSOCIATION.

HE BOWLED AT THE OLD TROPICANA BOWL, MIMOSA LANES, GULF GATE LANES, MEADOW CREEK LANES, NORTHSORE LANES, FEDERAL LANES AND STADIUM LANES IN HOUSTON AND AT FAIR LANES SPENCER SQUARE IN PASADENA. HE WAS THE MORNING CLASS INSTRUCTOR ON SATURDAY FOR ADULTS AND CHILDREN AT THE OLD PASADENA BOWLING LANES.

WE DO NOT KNOW HIS HIGHEST AVERAGE, BUT HE DID HAVE 1-SANCTIONED 300 GAME AT THE AGE OF 72 BOWLING A 777 HIGH SERIES. IN HIS APPROXIMATELY 60 YEARS OF BOWLING HE OFFERED MUCH TO THE SPORT OF AND ALTHOUGH WE LOST HIM ON JUNE 14, 1992, MANY IN AND OUT OF THE SPORT OF BOWLING WILL ALWAYS REMEMBER HIM.
